H. Materials

The Student understands that course tuition does include not any textbooks. Textbooks are to be purchased separately as needed by the student. The Student understands that extensive handouts for the course will be provided digitally before the start of each class and it is the responsibility of the student to print them out as needed.

2. **Course Fee:** The student shall pay the Sponsor a course fee of \$725 or \$675 early registration special if initial deposit is received by Jan 11, 2011. **All fees and tuition paid are nonrefundable unless the Sponsor cancels the course. This includes if you miss a class.** Payments will be received on the following schedule:
 - A. Initial deposit in the amount of \$200, received by Sponsor at time of registration. This holds you seat in the class and is nonrefundable unless the class is canceled.
 - B. The balance of the course fee is due on Jan 25, 2011.

3. **Evaluation:** There will be one test per module. It will be emailed to students after module finishes. There will be 100 multiple choice questions. A passing grade of 70% is considered passing. Certification given after each module. The student must have a passing grade on all three tests for the module to be awarded certification.
4. **Attendance:** There is no requirement for attendance in class to be awarded certification. Clearly attendance is desirable but it is no problem to miss a day or even an entire weekend. No refunds given for missed classes. Most students find

with additional support through study groups or using other students notes, they are able to make up missed material.

5. **Certificate:** Upon the student's satisfactory completion of the course and the Student's payment to the Sponsor of entire course fee, the Instructor shall provide the student with a Course Completion Certificate.
6. **Tutoring:** The Sponsor is not responsible for tutoring the Student. It is understood that it is the student's responsibility to arrange study groups with the other students as needed or to obtain the any additional guidance from the Instructor of the class.
7. **Flight Delays:** The Student understands that the instructors may have delayed flight times arriving in Orange Country due to Airport schedules/circumstances beyond the Sponsors control, so the class may not always start/end as it is scheduled.
